### Signs of a Male becoming Bāligh

- Wet dream Nocturnal Emission
- Child reaches 15 years in Islamic Age
   (14 years and 6 months)



Summary

### How to work out your Bāligh Date

Islamic Calendar Lunar Year = 354.367 Days

Western (Gregorian) Calendar Solar Year = 365.25 Days 15 Lunar Years

354.367 Days x 15

= 5315.505 Days

5315.505 / 365.25 Days (Solar Years)

**14.55** Years = **14** years & 6 months

6 months after 14th Birthday

#### Work out your Bāligh Date

Write down birth date

If born between January & June Write down Birth Year plus 14

If born between July & December Write down Birth Year plus 15

Write down the name of the month which is 6 months after birth month

Write down birth day

#### Example

Birth date = 1st January 2000

Bāligh date = 1st July 2014



# What is the correct method for urination?



## What are the problems with urinating standing up?

- Splashes from Urine will touch our clothes and body
- We will not be able to clean ourselves properly
- We cannot relieve ourselves totally
- Public Place risk of seeing each others private parts
- Hygienically greater chance of smell, infections etc.
- Cannot do Istibrā' properly





# Removing Hair from the Pubic Region

- Upper boundary = navel
- Distinct boundary between normal and pubic hair
  - Also remove hair on private part & scrotum

# Ideal method of removing hair





# Practical Method of Removal

- Use soap or shaving foam on hair
- Use a clean blade
- Start from the top right side and shave in a downward motion
- Remove all hair from above private part and sides
- Remove hair from scrotum
- Remove hair from private part
- · Wash area so hair is removed
- Repeat if necessary

Clean blade before putting it back

# Frequency of Removal



Advice for first timers A couple of questions



- Advise your children on how to remove hair
- Equip them with what they will need: razors, shaving foam etc
- Make them feel comfortable enough so they can talk to you



# Practical Method of Removal

- Use soap or shaving foam on hair

- Then shave the left armpit from top down
- Wash both armpits
- Repeat if necessary
- · Clean Ghusl Area

# Why do we need to do Wudu?

#### Sunan of Wudu

- Intention
- Saying Bismillāh
- Wash Hands upto Wrist 3 times
- · Brush teeth with Miswāk
- Gargle mouth 3 times
- Clean nose 3 times
- Khilāl of the beard
- Khilāl of the finger and toes
- Washing each part 3 times
- · Masah of whole head
- Masah of ears
- · Performing Wudu in order
- Washing each part one after another without pause so no part dries up before the next step

#### Nawāqid of Wudu

- Passing of Urine or Stool, or anything from the private parts
- Flowing of blood or puss
- Going mad or insane
- Fainting
- Falling asleep by resting against something or lying down
- · Vomiting a mouthful
- · Laughing in Salāt
- Passing Wind

#### Makrūhāt of Wudu

- Doing Wudu in a dirty place
- Talking of worldly affairs whilst performing Wudu
- · Cleaning the nose with the right hand
- · Performing Wudu against the Sunnah method

#### Mustaḥabāt of Wudu

- Facing Qiblah
- Sitting in a high and clean place
- Starting with the right
- Masah of the nape (back of the neck)
- Performing Wudu without any assistance

# Part 7 Masaḥ over Socks

## Masah over Socks

Why do Masah over socks?









# What type of Socks can we do Masaḥ on?

- Khuffayn Leather Socks
- Socks which satisfy the conditions the Fuqahā have stated





# How will the Masaḥ be done on the socks?

- Make complete Wudu, including washing the feet before putting on the socks
- When Wudu needs to be renewed, wipe the top part of each sock from the toes working back to the foreleg
- Use the right hand to wipe the right sock and the left hand to wipe the left sock

How Long will the Masah be valid for?

- Time period starts after initial Wudu breaks
- For a Muqim (resident) 24 hours
- For a Musāfir (traveller) 72 hours

#### Scenario

8:00 am - person does Wudu and puts on Masah Socks

10:00 am - person's Wudu breaks

Masaḥ valid until 10:00 am for the following day for a muqīm (resident)

For a traveller (Musāfir), Masaḥ will be valid for 72 hours

#### What breaks the Masaḥ?

- If 24 hours pass for a muqim (resident)
- if 72 hours pass for a musāfir (traveller)
- If socks are removed or accidentally come off

If Wudu breaks within the validity period of the Masah then only Masah needs to be done on the socks

# Can a person perform Masaḥ over cotton socks?

- There is no authentic Ḥadith which says that Masaḥ can be done over normal socks
- According to all 4 schools of thought, Masaḥ is not permissible on them
- If Masaḥ is performed on them, then it will not be valid and the Salāt performed with Masaḥ will also be invalid.

# Part 8 Masāil for young people

# What do you do if you have a wet dream?

- Prepare for ghusl right away
- Do not delay ghusl so you miss a Salāt
- Make instinjā first then perform ghusl in the Sunnah way
- Dispose of any impure clothes or sheets correctly
- Be quiet and discrete, if it is night time, no need to wake everyone up!
- If its the first time, inform your Parents if you can

#### **Advice for Parents**

- Inform your children of the changes their bodies will go through & wet dreams before they reach puberty
- Provide your children with spare sheets, pyjamas underwear, towels etc
- If someone experiences them often, advise them to wear pyjama bottoms, easier to wash them than bed sheets!
- Advise your children on what to do with impure clothes and bed sheets

## Common Questions & Answers

Question: Person wakes up thinking they have had a wet dream,

do they need to perform ghusl?

Answer: If there are no visible signs of the wet dream, then no need

to perform ghusl

Question: What do you do if you have a wet dream in a Masjid?

Answer: Don't delay ghusl. Wake up a senior member of the Jamāt so

they can escort you to the bathroom, perform ghusl and put on clean clothes. Do not leave any impure clothes or bedding

in the Masjid. Always remember to take spare clothes, a

towel and toiletries when going to Jamāt

## Advice for young people

- Have enough spares, underwear, towels, bed sheets pyjamas, etc.
- If you know how to use your washing machine, then wash clothes yourself
- If you need anything, dont be afraid to ask your parents
- Ask them how best to dispose of unclean clothes/bedding

Stay in a pure state at all times!
