Question 7 – Connections between different chapters and reconciling different narrations

- (a) What is the definition of travel in this Hadith according to the different scholars and their evidences? How is this narration reconciled? (5 Marks)
- (b) Are there any exceptions to the prohibition of travel according to the scholars? What conditions have to be fulfilled for the permissibility? Explain the difference of opinions and the evidences (5 Marks)
- (c) Zayd is a Hanafi and says it is permissible for women to travel with a group of women from Blackburn to Batley (50 English miles) for an Islamic programme because: (1) it takes less than one day to travel, and (2) according to Imam Shafi'ee this is permissible anyway, and (3) according to many Hanafi scholars this will not constitute travel. Do you agree? Explain and clarify and include the views of all four Imams and Imam Bukhari. (10 marks)
- (d) Fatima drives from Blackburn to Leicester with a group of women, will they shorten the prayer? What if they travel for obligatory Hajj? In both scenarios, are there any differences of opinions? (5 marks)
- (e) Yunus from the UK intends to stay in the Makkah/Mina area for five days. Will he shorten his prayer whilst he is in Mina on 8th Dhul Hijjah? Explain the difference of opinion of all four Imams and the view of Imam Bukhari. (5 marks)
