

## Preston Scholar's Dream

A colleague from Preston saw a dream on the night of Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> August and Friday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2017. He does not wish for his name to be disclosed. The following is his account:

“Alhamdulillah, on the night between Thursday and Friday, I was blessed with a dream in which I saw Hadhrat Shaykh al-Hadith Mawlana Muhammad Yunus Jawnpuri (may Allah have mercy on him). Hadhrat arrived in a hall that was brimming with ‘ulama from across the world. Perched on a chair he delivered a lesson in hadith that had the entire gathering enthralled. He was dressed in white clean clothes, in the way of our elders and as he would dress during his life. He, however, looked extremely young, with black hair and beard, with a special air of calmness and contentment around him. I heard him reading the text of hadith and could see him fully engrossed in reading and explaining. Unfortunately, I do not recall which hadith he narrated or the explanation. People who were present were pleasantly surprised that Hadhrat had returned and were clamouring over each other to invite him to their institutes and countries to lecture and teach. Then, all of a sudden, I found myself with Hadhrat in Pakistan walking with many people along a path to visit a madrasah. I then recalled I had some money to distribute to a friend there and began to regret I had not brought with me.”
