

## Last companions to pass away

### Question

Is it true that Anas ibn Mālik (may Allah be pleased with him) was the companion who passed away the last?

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

### Answer

This is not true. Anas ibn Mālik ؓ (d. 93/711-2) was the final companion to pass away in Basra. The companion to pass away the last in general was Abū al-Ṭufayl ʿĀmir ibn Wāthilah ؓ (d. 110/728-9) (refer to [this link](#) for more details). The last female companion to pass away was Umm Khālid bint Khālid ibn Saʿīd ibn al-ʿĀṣ ibn Umayyah ibn ʿAbd Shams ؓ (n.d) (refer to [this link](#) for more details).

The following table provides more information regarding the companions who passed away last in their regions as well as some other categories. The information is based on the preferred or dominant view of scholars. The age of some companions has been calculated. 18	ʿAbdullāh ibn ʿAbbās	68 AH	71	In Taif.
19	Abū Barzah al-Aslamī	65 AH	-	In Khorasan (Traxiane).
20	Umm al-Muʾminīn Umm Salamah	61 AH	-	From the wives of the Prophet ﷺ.
21	Jabr ibn ʿAtīk al-Anṣārī	61 AH	71	From the participants of the Battle of Badr. From the Anṣār participants of the Battle of Badr.
22	Qutham ibn al-ʿAbbās ibn ʿAbd al-Muṭṭalib	57 AH	-	In Samarqand (Samarkand).

23	Mu'tib ibn 'Awf ؓ	57 AH	78	From the muhājirūn (emigrants to Ethiopia/Eritrea). From the muhājirūn (emigrants to Madīnah) participants of the Battle of Badr.
24	Sa'd ibn Abī Waqqāṣ ؓ	55 AH	80+	From the 'Asharah Mubashsharah (the ten companions who were promised Paradise in one gathering).
25	Ka'b ibn 'Amr al-Khazrajī ؓ	55 AH	53	In Madīnah from the participants of the Battle of Badr.
26	Ruwayfi' ibn Thābit ؓ	53 AH	-	In Barqah (Cyrenaica, Pentapolis) - eastern coastal region of Libya, the Benghazi region.
27	Lubayy ibn Labā ؓ	-	-	In Wasit, Iraq.
28	Fāṭimah ؓ	11 AH	24	From the daughters of the Prophet ﷺ and his children.
